

How to Write An Abstract

Following is a standard format for writing an abstract:

| 1 | Sentence | Objective |
| 1-2 | Sentences | Experiment |
| 1-3 | Sentences | Results |
| 1-2 | Sentences | Conclusion |

The abstract is the essence of the whole work in one 250-word paragraph. It should summarize why the work was done and how, the results and conclusions, concluding with the significance.
