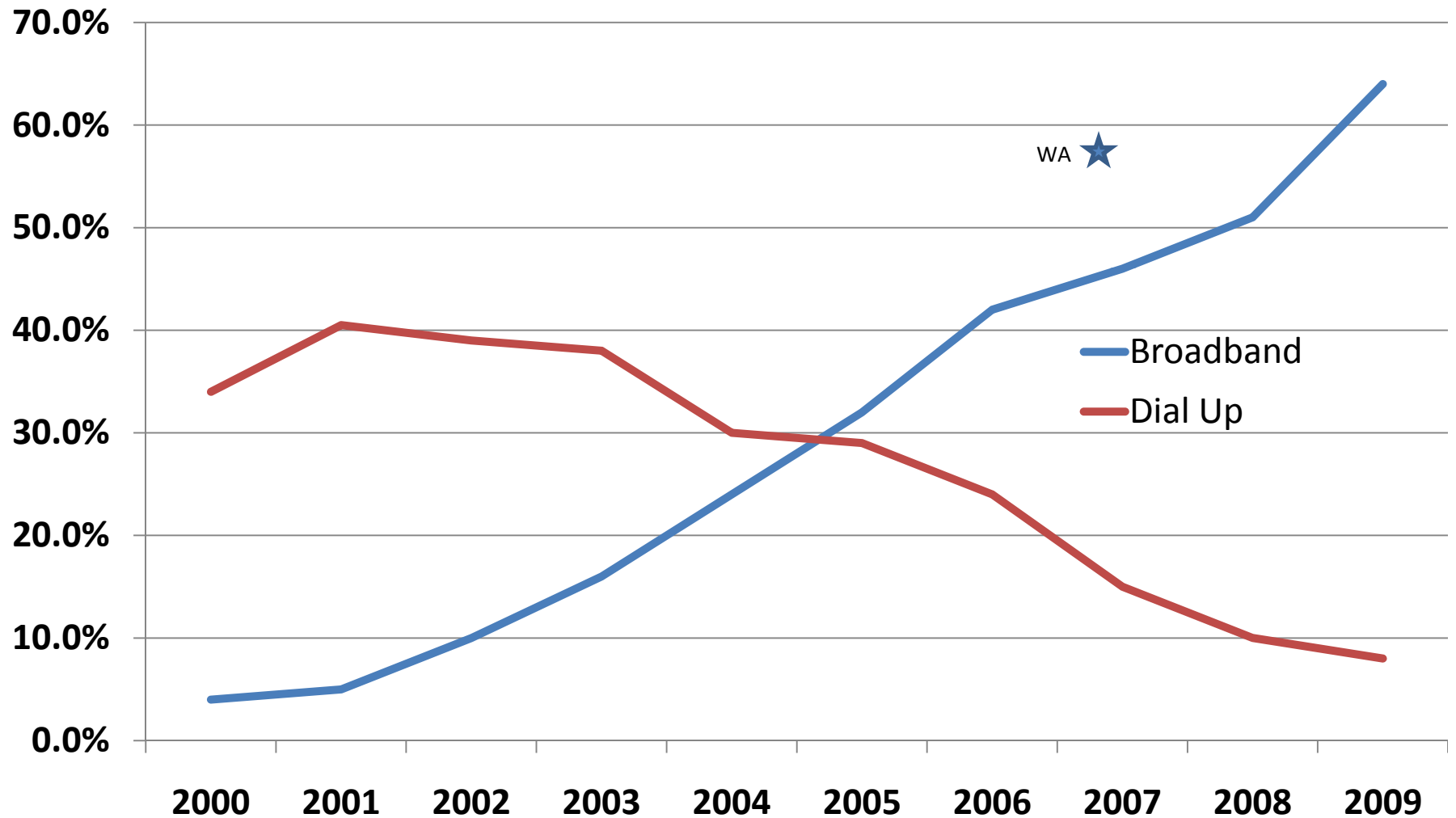
Learning Styles Are Changing

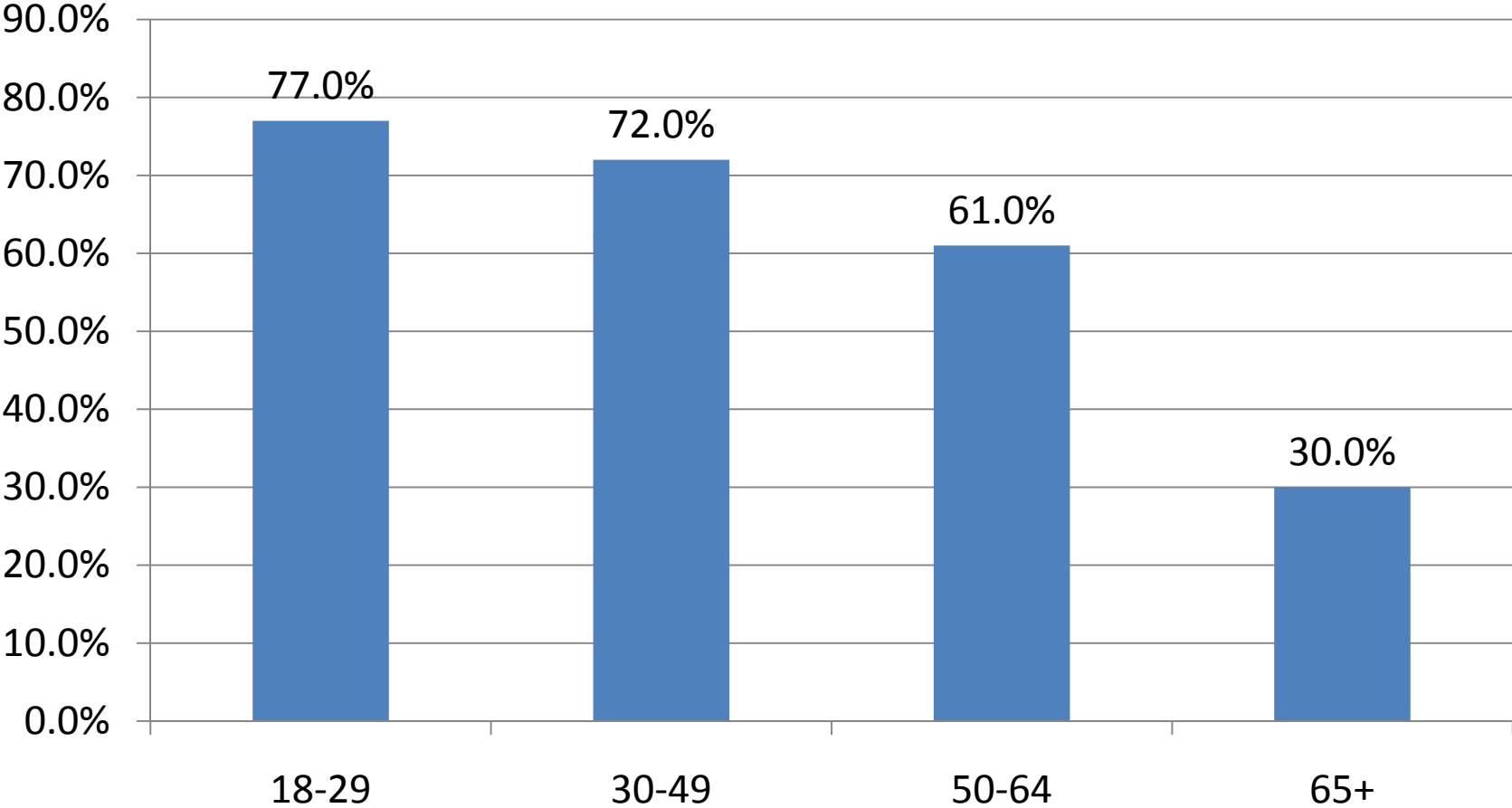
63% of Adult Americans Have Broadband Access (increased 15% last year alone)

# US Home Broadband and Dialup Access (Pew Internet & American Life Project)



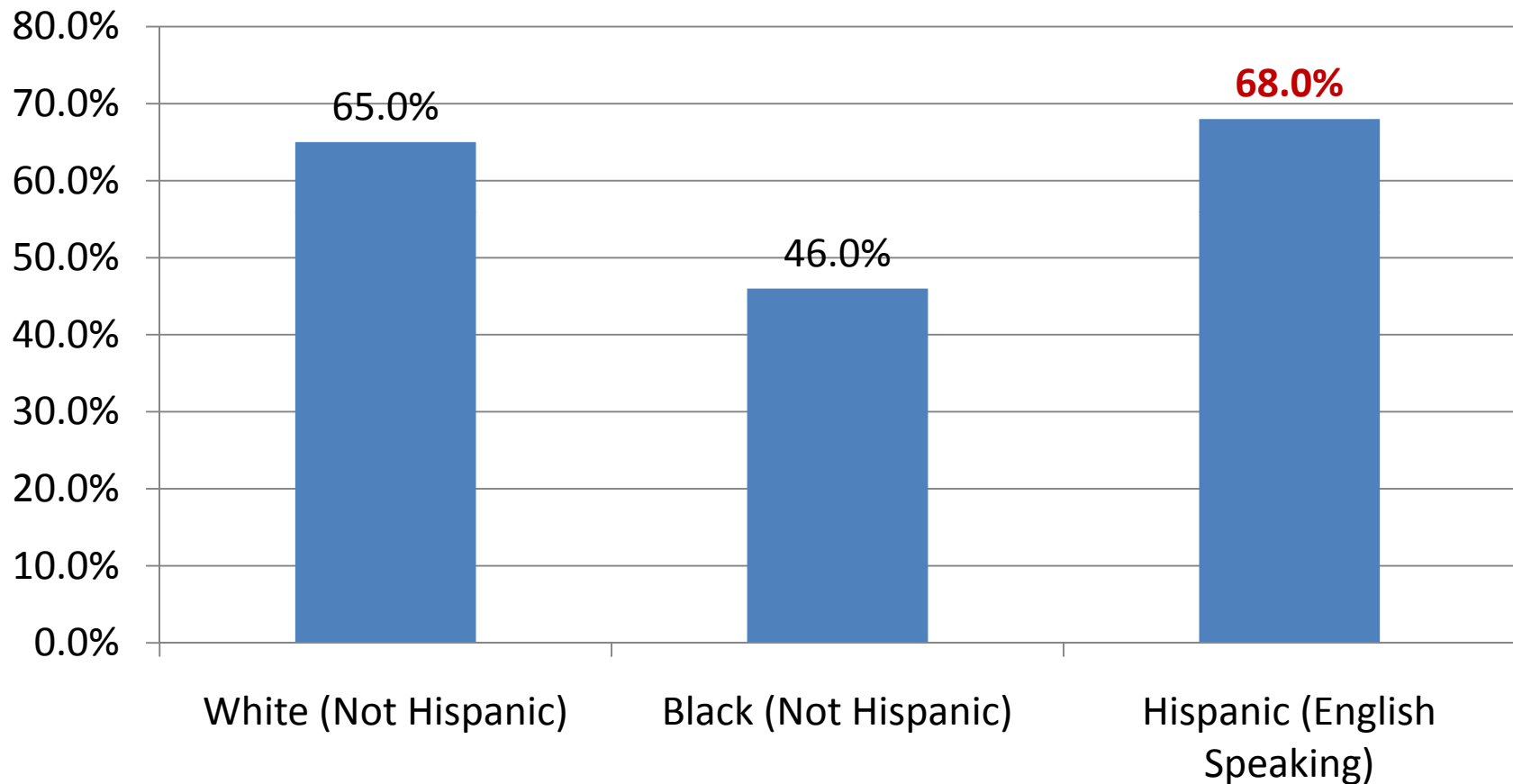
# Issue: Broadband Differs Across Ages

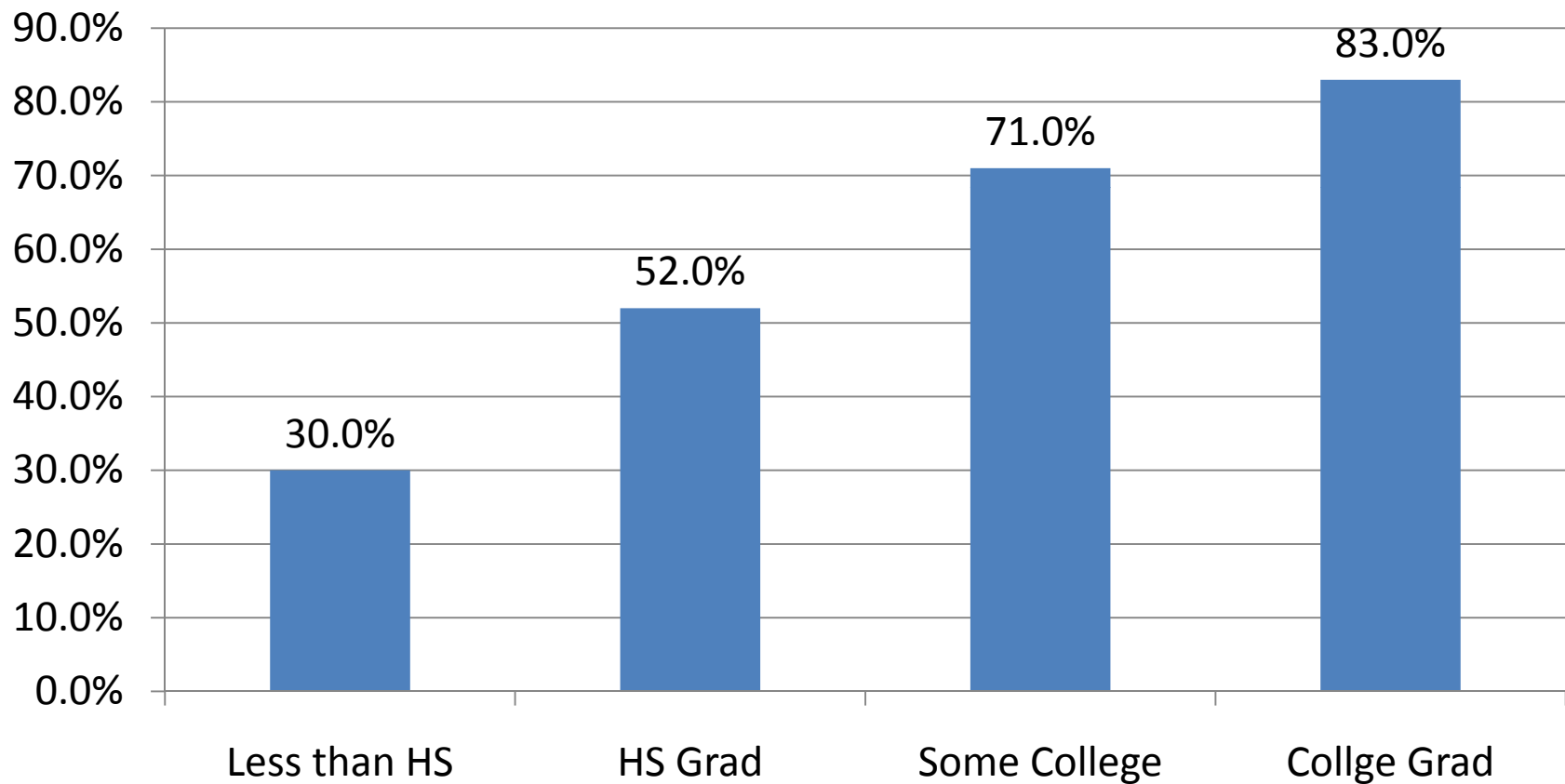
# Issue: Broadband Access Differs by Race and Ethnicity

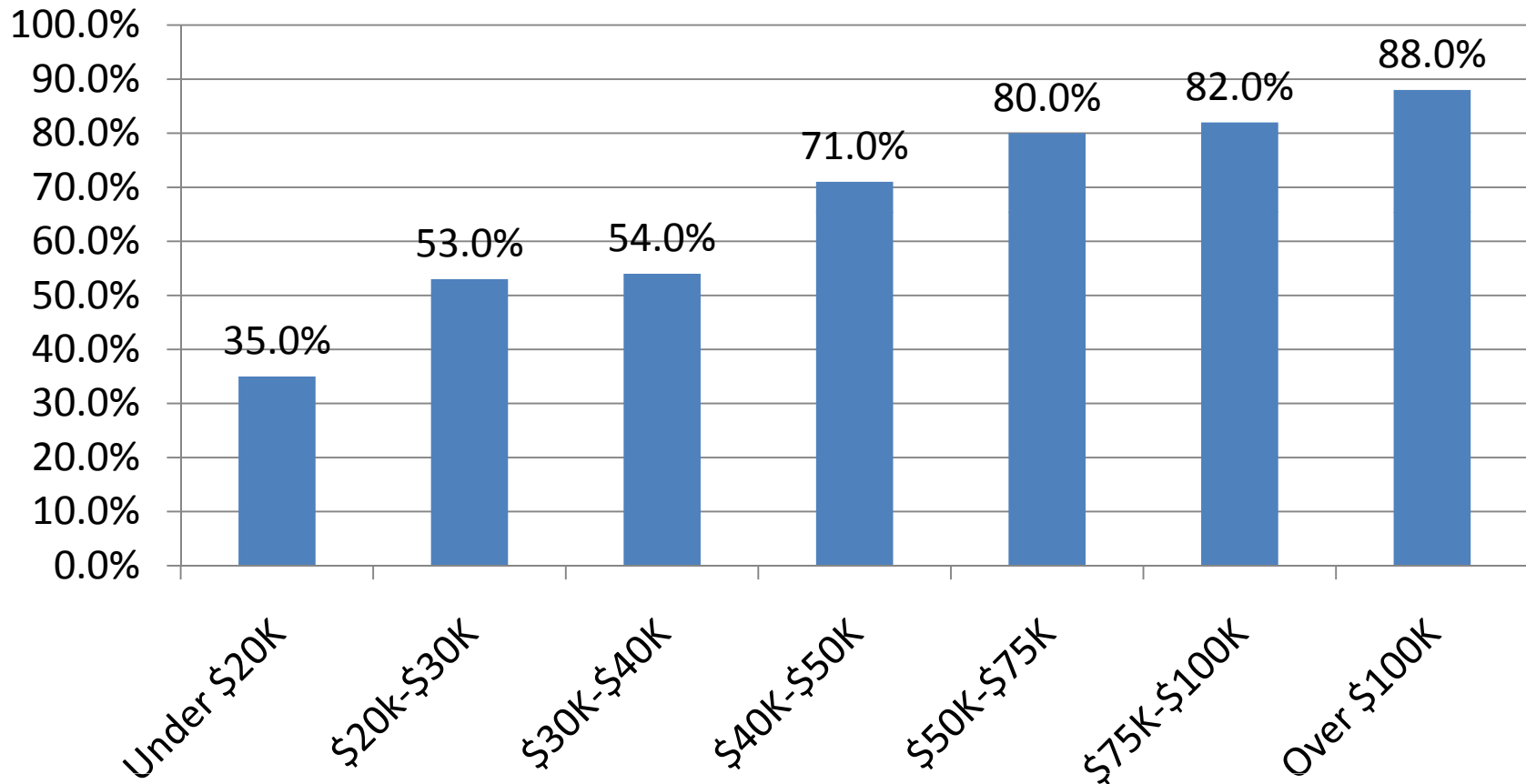
# Issue: Home Broadband Access Differs by Income

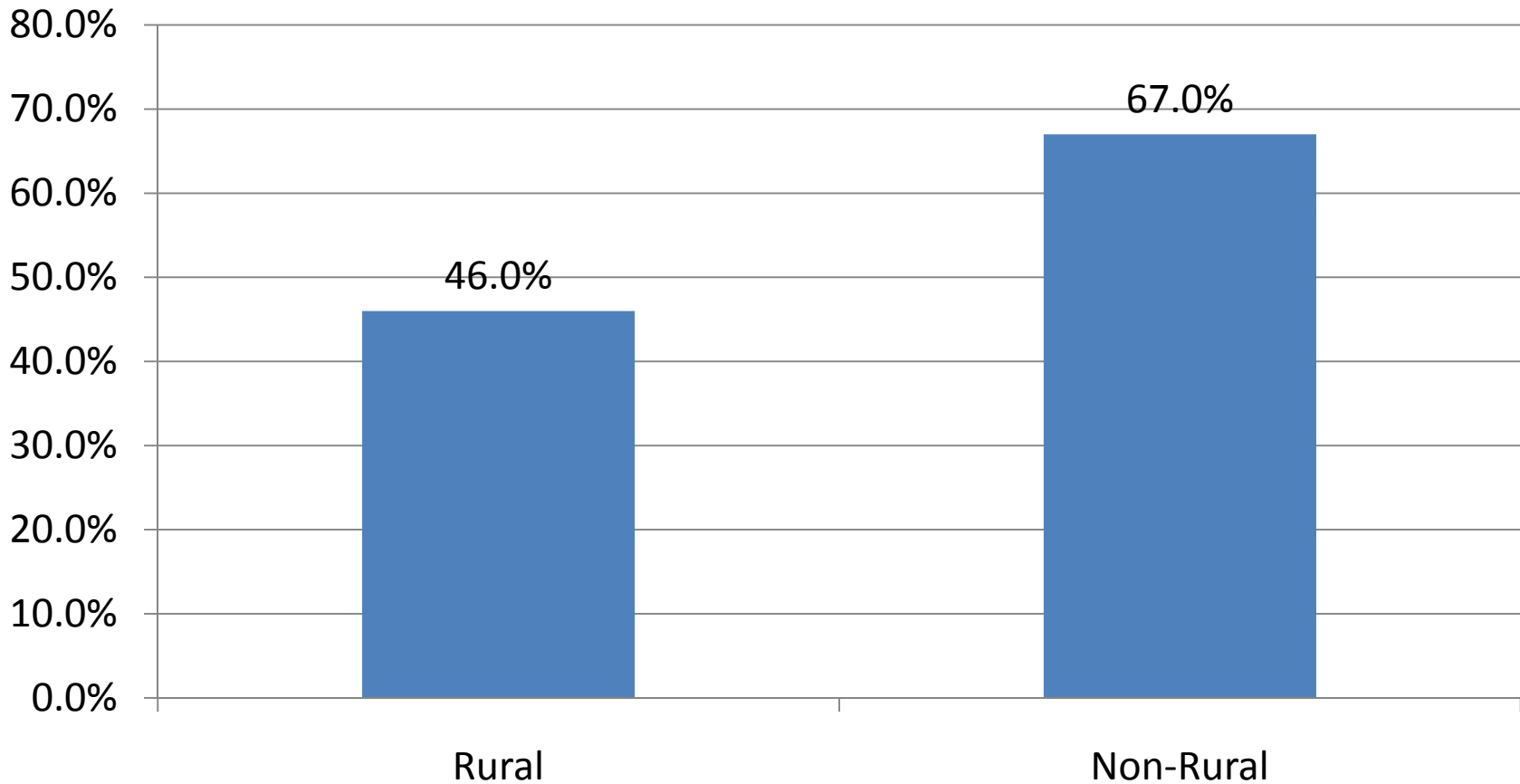


# Issue: Broadband Access Differs by Household Income
